Royal Air Force

Died 19th March 1944 Aged 29 Now rests in Prestwick Cemetery

Leading Aircraftman James Boyd

Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve

Died 14th December 1944 Aged 20 Now rests in Miami (Grand Army of the Republic) Cemetery, Oklahoma, USA

Lieutenant Hugh Cameron Gordon

Gordon Highlanders Attached to 12th Battalion, Nigeria Regiment Royal West African Frontier Force

Died 11th May 1945 Aged 33 Now rests in Madras War Cemetery, Chennai, India

Private Gilbert Murray Grier

8th Btn Argyll & Sutherland Highlanders

Died 22nd November 1942 Aged 25 Now rests in Tabarka Ras Rajel War Cemetery. This was the time of the final German defeat at El Alamein

Sergeant Norman Marshall Hannah

Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve

Died 6th, 7th June 1944 Aged 22 Now rests in Ayr Cemetery S

gt Norman Hannah was the wireless operator in Lancaster aircraft in the elite heavy bomber Squadron No 9. The aircraft crashed neat Belvoir castle in Leicestershire, returning from an attack on rail communications at Argentan. The 6th June 1944 was D-Day

Cadet Tom McGregor Hyslop

Merchant Navy

Died 25th March 1941 Aged 19 Remembered with honour on the Tower Hill Memorial, London.

Cadet Tom Hyslop was a cadet on the steamship Britannia when it was sunk 750 miles west of Freetown, Sierra Leone, Africa

Leading Airman James Birrell Kelly

Fleet Air Arm

Died 15th December 1941 Aged 21 Now rests in Prestwick Cemetery

LA James Kelly was at the time of his death serving in HMS Landrail with Royal Navy Air Station Machrihanish near Campbeltown.

Flying Officer Ian Edgar MacMaster

Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve

Died 18th March 1944 Aged 20 Now rests in Durnbach War Cemetery, Germany.

F/O Ian MacMaster was the pilot of a Lancaster aircraft in 625 Squadron. This aircraft was shot down while attacking a target near Frankfurt, Germany

Signaller John Laughland McVey

Royal Corps of Signals

Died 16th May 1944 Aged 21 Now rests in Imphal War Cemetery, Assam

Squadron Leader Ian Anderson Morrin

Royal Air Force

Died 8th April 1944 Aged 24 Now rests in Reichswald Forest War Cemetery, Germany.

Sqn Ldr Ian Morrin was Squadron Leader of 122 Squadron flying Mustang aircraft at the time he was killed on operations over Germany.
